


How to remove a Lighter profile Password


Follow this procedure if at every access to Lighter the following pop-up is shown and the user has forgotten the password:




This pop-up window can be shown when the user is opening Lighter, or when the user is opening a specific functionality of Lighter which is protected by a password.

Please take into account that **this procedure will remove every password that has been set in Lighter.**


1. Quit Lighter – Laser Engine: open the Laser Engine Icon from the Windows Notification Area by right-clicking on it. Then press 'Quit', as shown here:




2. Search for the *LaserEngine.exe*: find the filepath. In the case of the picture below, the filepath is “C:\Program Files\Lighter\6.2\”, as highlighted.



3. Open the Command Prompt Window from the 'Start' menu.



4. Insert the the commands: once you typed a line of commands, press 'Enter' to have your command executed. These are the simple MS DOS commands (*cd..,cd*):

5. Once the user has executed even the last command ('LaserEngine.exe --reset-user-db'), he can close the Command Prompt and access Lighter without the need of a password.
